## Changes to the Intermediary Authorisation Process

We have made some improvements to the authorisation process for intermediaries. These include

- An extension to the current form TC689 so that it can also cover Child Benefit This
  allows claimants to send us just one form when they have an intermediary acting for them
  for both tax credits and Child Benefit. The new forms enable your clients to choose
  whether you act on their behalf for tax credits, Child Benefit or both.
- 2. Authorisation periods will be for the length of time specified by your client. In the absence of a date being entered, authorisation will last for 4 months from the date of signature on the form TC689.
- 3. The facility to fax authorisation forms for urgent queries now covers both tax credits and Child Benefit issues.

You can fax to the same dedicated fax number and we will note the details of the authority on our records. We aim to do this within 48 hours of receipt of your fax. You can then ring us to discuss the query without the need for your client to be present.

## Please remember that this fax facility service is for urgent queries only.
