

You can stand and then move more than 1 metre but not more than 20 metres either aided or unaided.

Your total score for the **mobility** part of PIP is **22** points.

This means you've been awarded the **enhanced** rate.

My decision

You asked us to look again at the decision of 25 April 2017 not to proceed with your claim to Personal Independence Payment from 21 March 2017 because you were not present in Great Britain for 104 of the last 156 weeks prior to your claim.

I have looked again at regulation 17 of the Social Security (PIP) Regulations 2013 and confirm you can be treated as being present in Great Britain for the first 13 weeks of your absence abroad. This is because you had intended the absence to last less than 52 weeks therefore it is considered to be a temporary absence.

This means you have satisfied the past presence rule for qualifying for PIP because you have been present, or can be treated as having been present, in GB for 104 weeks out of 156 weeks prior to claiming PIP on 21 March 2017.

Although the request to look at this decision again was received outwith the time limits I have revised the decision of 25 April 2017 as it arose from an official error.
