Part 6 How we pay you

We pay money directly into your bank account

Finding out how much we have paid into the account

You can check your payments on account statements. The statements may show your National Insurance (NI) number next to any payments we have made. If you think a payment is wrong, get in touch with the office that pays you straight away.

If we pay you too much money

We have the right to take back any money we pay that you are not entitled to. We may have paid you money you were not entitled to because of the way the payment system works.
 For example, you may give us some information which means you are entitled to less money. Sometimes we may not be able to change the amount we have already paid you.
 This means we will have paid you money that you are not entitled to.
We will contact you before we take back any money.
