We cannot transfer your ESA award to your Universal Credit claim

Based on the outcome of your Work Capability Assessment made on your Employment and Support Allowance claim, you were awarded limited capability for work and work related activity.

This cannot be transferred from the ESA claim to your Universal Credit claim. The decision to award you the Support Group of ESA was made under ESA Regulations 2008. However Universal Credit Regulations 2013 do not allow a decision made under the 2008 ESA regulations to be transferred onto a Universal Credit claim.

You will be reassessed as soon as possible. We will contact you to let you know what you should do. You can be reassessed sooner if your health improves or deteriorates significantly. You should let us know straightaway about any changes to your health condition or disability as this can affect your claim.

We will contact you to look again at your Claimant Commitment.
