Thank you for your claim for ESA. Following your Work Capability Assessment, we've looked at your claim and we will continue to pay you ESA.

What this means for you

We know you have a disability, illness or health condition that limits the activities you can do. That's why we have put you in the **Support Group**.

We will pay you your usual account every two weeks. Your next payment is due on

What is the support group

Being in the Support Group means you won't have to go to meetings with a work-coach or take part in activities to help you get into work.

If you did want to, you could speak with one of our specialist work-coaches who can help you get training to learn new skills.

Future Work Capability Assessments

We won't ask you to go for another assessment unless there is a change in your health condition.

It's important you tell us straightaway about any changes that could affect the amount of ESA you get.
