You asked to be treated as a dependant on the asylum application of asylum application has been carefully considered and this letter is to advise you of the outcome of that decision

It has been decided that qualifies for asylum. It has also been decided that as their dependant, you have also been recognised as a refugee and granted leave until 2 February 2028.

This letter <u>does not</u> confirm you have leave, give you the right to work or allow you access to benefits.

As you have already enrolled your biometrics, you will receive a Biometric Residence Permit¹,("BRP") with a separate letter shortly. Your BRP will be your proof of leave in the UK and will allow you to work or claim benefits.
