How much you will get

Most people will be entitled to the same amount or more on Universal Credit.

If the amount you are entitled to on your existing benefits is more than you would get on Universal Credit, a top up is available. This is called transitional protection.

This migration notice entitles you to transitional protection if your circumstances do not change before you claim Universal Credit.

If your circumstances change before you make your claim this may affect the amount you get.

You should claim as soon as possible to make sure the amount you are currently entitled to can be protected.

If you have certain types of debt this may affect the amount of Universal Credit you get. Call 0800 169 0328 if you think this will affect you.

If you live with your partner

You will both need to claim Universal Credit by the same deadline. You must make a joint claim for your household, even if your partner is not eligible for Universal Credit.

If you do not intend to claim Universal Credit

If you do not intend to claim Universal Credit your existing benefits will end and you will not receive further financial support. Call us on 0800 169 0328 to let us know.
