Additional Information:

- 1. I am writing to confirm to the Tribunal that the obtaining of an Examining Medical Practitioner Report (EMPR) is not now a service that the Department carries out in relation to Attendance Allowance claims.
- 2. Historically this was an instance in which a claimant could be visited in their own homes by a healthcare professional who would compile their report following medical examination.
- 3. I have obtained a General Practitioner's Factual Report (GPFR) which I have enclosed now. This was completed by free General Practitioner on @ July 2023.
- 4. I have also attached a copy of a letter the Department has sent to Mr. Member of Parliament's office. I hope both documents assist the Tribunal to come to a decision at the next hearing of the same as appeal.
